



2009 Cupcake Contest All American Red, White, and Blue Festival

A **BRAND NEW** competition has been added to the popular Apple Pie Contest this year. This will be a contest for children age 17 and younger.

Here's How It Works: Contestants need to bake and decorate 6 cupcakes alike. 5 will be eaten by the five judges, and 1 will be judged for original presentation. The presentation cupcake needs to be on a plate that can be shown to the judges. The plate may be decorated, but only the cupcake will be judged. Cupcakes will be judged as follows:

- 50% - Originality and creativity
- 25% - Taste
- 25% - Presentation to Judges on plate



Cupcake decorations are NOT limited to patriotic designs.

Cupcakes need to be able to remain at room (air) temperature for several hours. Bring all of the cupcakes to the ground floor of the Adair County Courthouse between 2 pm and 4:00 pm on Friday, July 3, 2009. No cupcakes will be accepted after 4:00, without prior arrangements. Judging will begin at 6 pm and will take place on the lawn of the courthouse at the same time as the Apple Pie judging.
