RE: 2009 APPLE PIE CONTEST and CUPCAKE CONTEST

I am asking you to consider baking a pie for the annual All American Red, White and Blue Pie Contest OR Pie Auction again this year. The Pie Contest & Pie Auction has always been a fun part of the Festival. The 2009 Planning Committee has decided to continue the tradition again this year. We hope you are willing to participate.

The Committee has also added a **Cupcake Contest** this year. If you know of a child age 17 and under that likes to cook and decorate cupcakes, please pass the enclosed Cupcake Contest information along (or, plan to grab your grandkids or neighbor kids and decorate some cupcakes!).

Please find enclosed a 2009 All American, Red, White, and Blue Apple Pie Contest/Auction registration form and the Cupcake Contest registration form.

Pies & cupcakes must be homemade (cupcakes can, of course, be made from a cake mix) and delivered to the West Entrance of the Adair County Courthouse (across from the Cinema) between 2-4 p.m. on Friday, July 3rd. Pie Contestants must provide **2 pies** - one for judging and one for auction. Cupcake Contestants must provide **6 cupcakes** – five for the judges and one for presentation.

Judging will take place at 6 p.m. on the south side of the Adair County Courthouse. Immediately following the Pie Contest, the Pie Auction will commence with pies being auctioned off to the highest bidder. Please provide pies in non-returnable containers. Cupcakes will not be auctioned.

If you do not wish to enter the Apple Pie Contest or Cupcake Contest, you may donate a pie of any flavor to the pie auction. All proceeds from the auction will go towards the Chamber's July 4th Festival Fund. Please deliver your pies to the West Entrance of the Adair County Courthouse (across from the Cinema) between 2-4 p.m. on Friday, July 3, 2009.
