AMS (Area Mailing & Shipping) was started by Carl Baldwin in January 1991 to fill a void in the mailing needs of Kirksville and the surrounding area. Carl's specialty is in Standard Mail (bulk mail). Over the years AMS has mailed for local universities and colleges, political campaigns, retail businesses, fraternities, sororities and other organizations. AMS handles both regular and non-profit mail.

AMS maintains a bulk mail permit with the local post office, so Carl can mail for other entities and individuals. AMS uses the permit to mail standard mailings.

As owner of AMS Carl has received seven professional development certificates from the United States Postal Service, including an award in Quality Mail preparation.

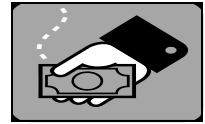
