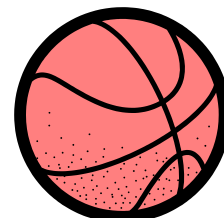

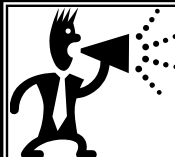
## Bulldog Free Throw Contest
