**Chamber By-Laws Amendment**

*The By-Laws may be emended upon the vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members in good standing present at any membership meeting, provided that written notice of the proposed amendment has been mailed to each member's post office address of record at least ten (10) days prior to such meeting. A vote on the proposed Article IX, Section 1. Budget. Amendment will occur at the September 16th Business After Hours.*

**ARTICLE IX—FINANCES**

**SECTION 1. Budget.** In September, the President shall appoint, subject to the approval of the Board, the Budget and Finance Committee. This committee shall meet throughout the year and consist of the Treasurer, President, two (2) Directors, and two (2) from the general membership. The purpose of this committee is to prepare an annual budget report that will be submitted to the Board at the regular November monthly board meeting for consideration and modification or approval. In addition, this committee will meet on a quarterly basis to review the Chamber financial operations and make any comments/suggestions to the Board regarding such.
