Northeast Missouri Health Council, Inc. • 902 East LaHarpe • Kirksville Congratulations to Deb Wheeler from Northeast Missouri Health Council, Inc. She is the Director of Human Resources at NMHC and her business card was drawn at the December Business After Hours.

From pediatrics to geriatrics, NMHC offers a wide variety of medical and dental services and programs to area residents. Patients pay based on their personal circumstances, and for those who need payment assistance, the Council offers a "sliding fee" schedule for which qualifications are determined by income level and family size. An independent board of directors whose members reside in counties served by the Council oversees the program.

In addition to family practice clinics in Kirksville, Edina, Memphis, Milan, and Princeton, NMHC manages five other clinics in Kirksville: Northeast Missouri Dental Clinic, Northeast Missouri Pediatrics, the OB/Gyn Specialty Group, the Women's and Family Health Clinic, and the Veterans Clinic. The organization maintains a Behavioral Health Department and the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program for Adair County is also affiliated with the Council.

NMHC became one of the first community health centers in the nation to be funded by the Office of Women's Health as a Community Center of Excellence in Women's Health. The Women's Care Connection (WCC) addresses women's health from a women-centered, multidisciplinary, cultural and community-based perspective and assists women in eight counties.

A not-for-profit corporation, NMHC was established in 1968 to develop and maintain a network of regional, primary, and preventive health care clinics and providers, and to improve clinic accessibility and utilization. The Council was originally affiliated with Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine, but split into a separate corporation in 2002 and has since more than tripled in size, currently employing more than 140 employees in Northeast Missouri. The organization still maintains close ties with A.T. Still University/KCOM, as well as a strong working relationship with Northeast Regional Medical Center, especially in the areas of education and resident training.


Retail Merchants Committee Forming
