Beverly Powell — Vintage Book Shoppe and Typing Services

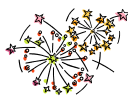
Thanks Beverly, for attending June's Business After Hours and congratulations for having your business "spotlighted" this month!

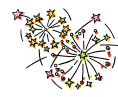
Beverly buys, sells, and trades used books that are in good condition. Stop by the store to get a copy of the store's buying, selling and trading policy.
